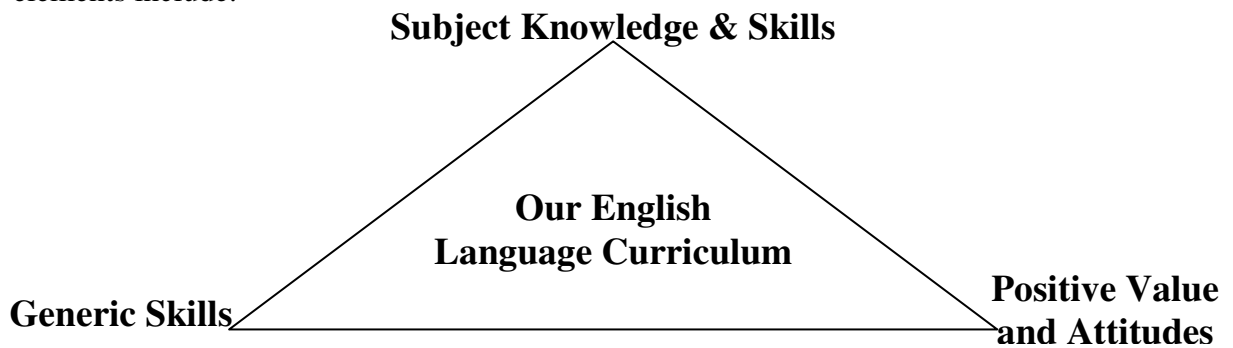

Our long-upheld belief ...

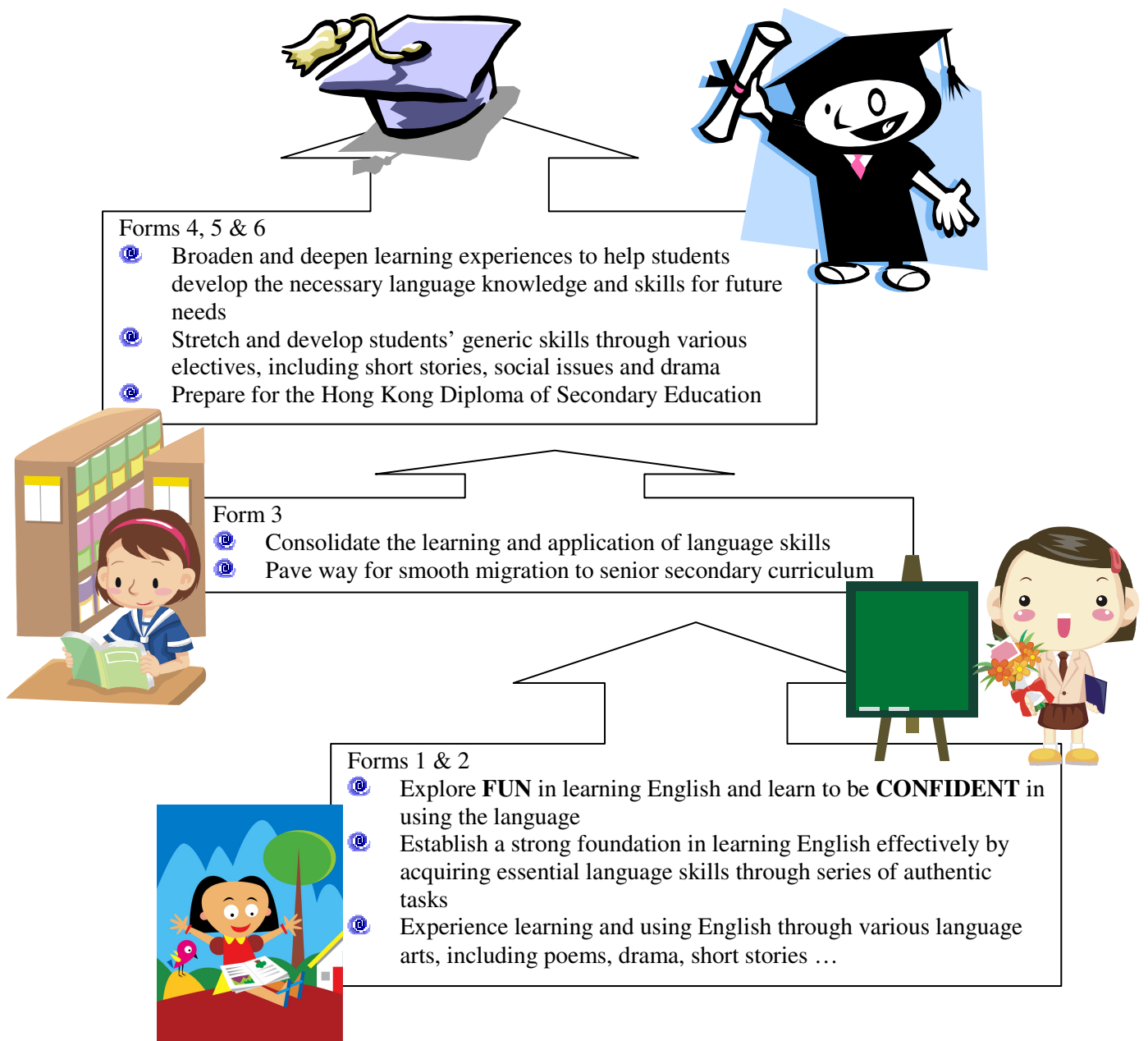

- Catering for individual learning differences through tailor-made learning and teaching materials and comprehensive Remedial and Enrichment Programmes

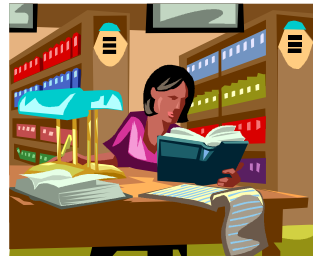


After learning English through the interface between the junior and senior secondary curricula at our school, our girls will be able to ...

 - Cross-curricular learning (the use of English in other subjects taught in English)
 - Extra-curricular activities
- **Expand your vocabulary bank by:**
 - Keeping a vocabulary book
 - Learning the contextualized meaning, spelling, parts of speech and pronunciation of the vocabulary item
- **Learn from mistakes by:**
 - Reflecting on feedback from teachers or peers
 - Doing corrections
