Singapore Multi-cultural Exchange Tour

A Singapore Multi-cultural Exchange Tour was held between 18th April and 21st April 2011. 26 students of our school joined the program. The tour was composed of two themes, academic exchange with local secondary schools and sight-seeing.

We visited the Hong Ka Secondary School on the second day of the trip. About half a year ago, the school sent a group of students to Hong Kong and exchanged ideas with us. When our students
