Miss Wong: "LKL girls can be more confident!"

Q: Why do you want to be a teacher?

A: I want to choose a job which can make a contribution to the society and salary is not my first concern. At first, I wanted to become a policewoman but I could not pass the eyesight test. So I chose to be a teacher. I think being a teacher can make a difference on not only my life, but also students'. And I believe I can be a good teacher.

Q: Can you suggest some methods for LKL's students to improve their study?

A: I think they must pay attention during lessons because if you do not pay attention, you will miss some important knowledge and then it may cause problems when you learn new knowledge.

Q: Can you give some words of encouragement to LKL's students?

A: I think many LKL's students lack confidence. A lot of girls are worried about standing out from the rest. So I hope they can be more confident and the school can give more opportunities to them to enrich their knowledge on different aspects and reinforce their confidence.

This year, we have several new faces in our LKL family and one of them is Miss Wong Wing Shan. Before meeting Ms Wong, we heard some rumors about her strict teaching style and a few students told us that they were afraid of her. But after our interview with Ms Wong, we found that she is a really nice teacher. She admitted that her teaching style was straight but she said that she would love to have some chit-chats with students after lessons if they needed.

It is normal that we will encounter some difficulties when fitting in a new environment, but Miss Wong is doing quite well on this. When Miss Wong shared the difficulties she had in the first year of teaching in LKL, she said that she had taught in a girl's school before, so teaching in a girl's school was not very challenging for her. But some of the school's policies, such as detention class, are something new to her. She did feel a bit difficult to accommodate with this policy at the first place, and yet she overcomes it now.

Do you notice that Miss Wong is pregnant? Congratulations, Ms Wong! During this interview, Miss Wong sounded really happy when she talked about her pregnancy. And I asked if her pregnancy would affect her working performance. Miss Wong did not think it was an obstacle to her. We can't wait to see Miss Wong's newborn baby!

At the end of the interview, Miss Wong gave our girls some lovely advice. She hopes that we can be more confident and she said that she would love to see our changes. "Be brave and be confident," she said.

Mr. Chung: "Actions speaks louder than words."

Q: Being a new teacher, have you encountered any difficulties?

A: I need to accommodate myself to the school policy. This school's policy is different from some schools like my mother school, for example, homework submission scheme and detention class. Also, I think it is not easy to communicate with a whole class of girls.



Q: How do you overcome those difficulties?

A: I have allocated the time better than before and tried my best to adapt to the system. And I have found more opportunities to talk with girls and get some advice from them, which can help me communicate with girls more easily.

Q: Do you have any unforgettable experiences in LKL?

A: There were two of classes which had held birthday parties for me. I was surprised about that. It was very sweet and thoughtful of them. Students' support is very important to me because it can encourage teachers to work harder.

In the classroom, looking forward, I spot an enthusiastic teacher standing on the podium and he is our new teacher, Mr Chung. Unanimously, Mr Chung is a charming and passionate teacher and the way he teaches receives many compliments from most students who have been taught by him. Even though he has already had a good reputation among schoolmates, he still tries his best to improve his teaching skills. We asked about what he wanted to achieve as a teacher. He wants to keep a good impression in students' mind. Besides, he also wants to have good communication with his students. Apart from that, Mr. Chung also faces some obstacles in his first year of teaching. He said he still needed some more time to develop an appropriate teaching style "to be a gentle teacher" or "to be a strict teacher". Both styles can create completely different impression on schoolmates and even have a great impact on his teaching career. Besides, he also tries to strengthen his teaching skills in order to help students learn about current affairs from different perspectives.

As a Liberal Studies teacher, Mr Chung does not avoid teaching any sensitive issues. In contrast, he thinks our students need to discuss those topics. Thus, he teaches those sensitive issues by sharing personal opinions and also different stakeholders' stances so that our schoolmates can reflect on the issue from different angles.

In addition, Mr Chung raised some problems concerning class association. Firstly, the class association is not united enough and it can organize more activities for students to develop closer relationships between each other. Moreover, students' social skills can be improved.

Finally, Mr Chung gave us a recommendation, which is 'actions speak louder than words'.
