Interview with Mr. Chan Tsz Tung

Mr Chan chose to teach in our school because he grew up in Tuen Mun and he knew that our school is a well-known school in the region. Students in the school are honest and well-behaved. Therefore, he is happy to become a new teacher in our school this year.

Mr Chan explained that the reason why he became a teacher was a coincidence. When he was studying in university, he had a chance to be a teaching assistant. It was the first time for him to teach. However, he thinks some girls in our school are passive and do not ask questions when they do not understand the lessons.

When asked about what he would do if a student had behavioral problems, he said that he would chat with them to find out the reasons behind the problems. He is sure that if he does not find out the reasons behind students' behavioral problems, it is not really helping them.

He hopes when students have questions that they do not understand, they can just feel free to ask teachers for help and not wait until examinations. He also hopes that our schoolmates will focus more on studies and try their best to improve their studies.
